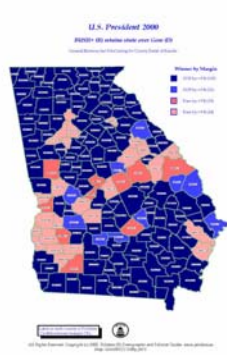

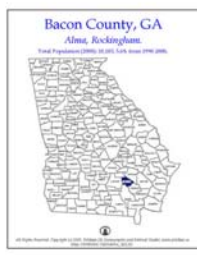

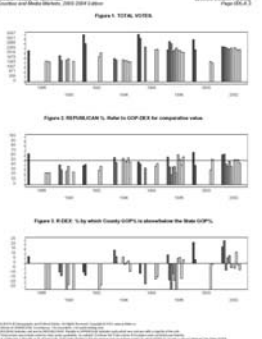


County Locator Map
