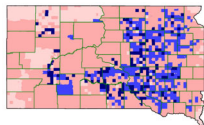

The results were selected to provide a good cross-section of key demographic areas, provide some useful information for key demographic areas, and provide a range of geographical information.

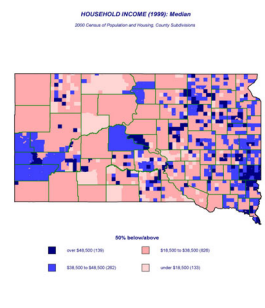

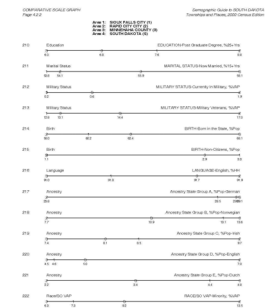
