3. All percentages are rounded and may not add to 100. Likewise, the margins may be slightly off. Inconsistencies exist in the tabulation of votes for minor party candidates.

4. Districts with a close margin in the Presidential vote are flagged by a pound sign (#). Use these data with a healthy degree of skepticism.

5. Pres/Cong is indicated for "turnover" districts. In 2004, BD for BUSH DEMOCRAT; KR for KERRY REPUBLICAN. In 2000, BD for BUSH DEMOCRAT, GR for GORE REPUBLICAN.

6. Bush/Bush reflects a change in the Presidential outcome over the previous election.
