NOTES:

- 1. The POLIDATA projections are for April 1, 2000 and are calculated by applying an estimated growth rate (%) to the recently released annual estimate for 1998. The POLIDATA projections do not consider when during the year the net growth occurs. A full year is applied to 1998 for July 1, 1998 to July 1, 1999. From July 1, 1999 to April 1, 2000, only 75% of the net persons are considered.
- 2. The POLIDATA projections do not take into account any overseas persons who might be added to the apportionment population for the U.S. House.
- 3. The POLIDATA projections use several models to calculate a projection for April 1, 2000. All are initially based upon the 1998 Annual Estimate. For each model, the 1998 to 1999 rate is applied first, then 75% for 2000.
- 4. The preferred series of state-level projections by POLIDATA is Series B, 2yr WA. Prj B-2yr WA is a weighted average with the growth rate for 97 to 98 counting a weight of 2 and the rate from 96 to 97 counting a weight of 1.
- 5. The level of precision used for the percentage rate is only 2 decimal places.
