Gallatin County	The county was expanded by addition of territory from the former county equivalent of Yellowstone National Park, effective November 7, 1997
Park County	The county was expanded by addition of territory from the former county equivalent of Yellowstone National Park, November 7, 1997
Yellowstone National Park	That part of Yellowstone National Park within Montana formerly was not within a county and was treated as a county equivalent for statistical data tabulation purposes. In November 7, 1997, the area was dissolved as a county equivalent and its territory subdivided between Gallatin County and Park County, Montana; this change eliminates Yellowstone National Park (FIPS:113) as a county equivalent
Fairview town	Area description change, from city to town, effective 12/30/97
