Clinchco town, Dickenson County	new incorporation, effective May 1, 1990 (Census place: 0290; FIPS:17504)
Covington city	independent city annexation of area from Alleghany County, effective December 31, 1990
Fairfax city	independent city annexation of area from Fairfax County, effective January 1, 1994
