
DEMOGRAPHIC ATLAS OF OHIO; TOWNSHIPS AND PLACES, 1990 CENSUS EDITION

Geographic base maps for several levels of census geography; a table of selected demographic factors for each county subdivision and place; and a complete census profile for the county; all together in a separate section <u>for every county</u> in the state. A valuable reference tool for any research into the demographics or politics of the Buckeye State.

- \Rightarrow State locator maps pinpoint the area of the state where the county is located, naming the population centers and summarizing the growth of the county since the 1990 census (page 1);
- ⇒ A page-length census profile is included for every county, summarizing scores of demographic factors into a few dozen categories. Each factor includes the appropriate percentage calculation and an indicator of the comparison of the value for the county with the value for the state. The five data paragraphs are formatted to minimize cross-referencing to other sources. The concise format provides a complete demographic profile in one location (page 2);



- \Rightarrow A geographically arranged table lists a handful of representative factors from the 1990 Census of Population and Housing for every county subdivision and the places which lie therein; geographic codes are included (page 3);
- \Rightarrow Base maps are provided for multiple levels of census geography: a) county subdivisions, b) incorporated and census designated places, c) census tracts and block groups (pages 4-6);



⇒ An Appendix includes several useful statewide reference tools: 1) Census Bureau county subdivision maps; 2) a County Code Listing with FIPS codes, population centers, county seats, and 1990, 1994 population; 3) statewide base maps for Counties, OMB's Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs), Nielsen's Designated Marketing Areas (DMAs), and Polidata's Internal State Regions (ISRs); and 4) an alphabetical index of county subdivisions and places.

Each county section is a self-contained set of at least six pages, all full-sized 8.5x11 inch pages designed for easy photocopying. Insets are provided for a few selected counties. A section for each of Ohio's 88 counties includes maps and representative factors for 1,553 county subdivisions and 838 places.

The ATLAS is designed to provide basic information and base maps for every township and place in the state. Another POLIDATA demographic tool tailored specifically to OHIO— the perfect geographic companion to the DEMOGRAPHIC GUIDE TO OHIO.
