
POLITICAL GUIDE TO OHIO; CITIES AND TOWNSHIPS, 1995-1996 EDITION

Political election information for every city and township in the state: arranged into rankings, thematic maps and basic profiles. Rankings and maps are provided for over 50 political factors; AREA PROFILES summarize factors for a decade of elections into five data paragraphs containing appropriate percentages and relativity indicators for statewide comparison. A valuable reference tool for any research into the politics or other demographics of the Buckeye State.

- \Rightarrow Rankings of all cities and townships for over 50 political factors; separate rankings for all 88 counties and 1,600+ county subdivisions;
- \Rightarrow Thematic (shaded) maps illustrate the regional distribution of each of the 50+ rankings, highlighting the areas of highest & lowest concentration for all 1,600+ county subdivisions;

The abridged summaries for smaller areas include portions of all paragraphs except the detail of 2 for specific election. Paragraph 5 summarizes multiple elections for every jurisdiction.

- \Rightarrow Each of the over 1,600+ election profiles can be found quickly and easily in moments through the convenience of the alphabetically arranged Gazetteer portion of the book.
- ⇒ An Appendix includes several useful statewide reference tools: 1) Census Bureau county subdivision maps; 2) a Full Data Record listing enabling a detailed comparison of all demographic factors for the state and the three largest areas in the state; 3) a Political Directory for Congress and the Legislature; and 6) statewide Election Summary Tables; and 4) maps showing the Party Control for Congress and the legislative chambers.

The rankings and thematic maps are each full-sized 8.5x11 inch pages designed for easy photocopying. Profiles are included for all of Ohio's 88 counties, 1,600+ county subdivisions. Complete profiles are included for communities with over 1,000 votes in the 1992 election. Abridged summaries for the smaller areas still summarize the election behavior of the unit.

The POLITICAL GUIDE is designed to provide a readable political election profile of basic information in a concise format for every county subdivision in the state. It is another POLIDATA political tool tailored specifically to OHIO. Not just another data book, but a ready source of election profiles and a book with its entire analytical focus on the BUCKEYE STATE.
